uses a comic book format to shed light on the complex and emotionally charged situation of palestinian arabs exploring the lives of israeli soldiers palestinian refugees and children in the occupied territories

sacco brings the conflict down to the most human level allowing us to imagine our way inside it to make the desperation he discovers in some small way our own rafah a town at the bottommost tip of the gaza strip has long been a notorious flashpoint in the bitter middle east conflict buried deep in the archives is one bloody incident in 1956 that left 111 palestinians shot dead by israeli soldiers seemingly a footnote to a long history of killing that day in rafah cold blooded massacre or dreadful mistake reveals the competing truths that have come to define an intractable war in a quest to get to the heart of what happened joe sacco immerses himself in the daily life of rafah and the neighboring town of khan younis uncovering gaza past and present as

in palestine his unique visual journalism renders a contested landscape in brilliant meticulous detail spanning fifty years moving fluidly between one war and the next footnotes in gaza transforms a critical conflict of our age into intimate and immediate experience
